PLEASE REVIEW THE FOLLOWING VOLUNTEER GUIDELINES AND KULEANA BELOW:
• ARRIVE ON TIME: • ARRIVE PROMPTLY AND CHECK IN WITH THE KE'ENA NO LATER THAN 7:30A.
 ■ BE PRESENT AND ENGAGED: VOLUNTEERS ARE EXPECTED TO BE FULLY PRESENT AND FOCUSED DURING THE ENTIRE EVENT.
● NO CHILDREN: ○ FOR LIABILITY REASONS, VOLUNTEERS MUST BE AN ADULT. NON-K'UK KEIK SHOULD NOT BE IN YOUR CARE DURING YOUR SHIFT.
• STAY FOR THE FULL DURATION: • VOLUNTEERS ARE EXPECTED TO REMAIN ON-SITE FOR THE ENTIRE DURATION OF THEIR ASSIGNED SHIFT.
COMMIT TO 'ŌLELO HAWAI'I: ○ WHENEVER POSSIBLE, USE 'ŌLELO HAWAI'I TO SUPPORT THE CULTURAI ATMOSPHERE OF THE EVENT.
● DRESS APPROPRIATELY: ○ WEAR CLOTHING THAT ADHERES TO KA 'UMEKE KĀ'EO STUDENT DRESS CODE. II YOU HAVE A KA 'UMEKE UNIFORM PLEASE WEAR IT.
